2010 Systematic Inspection Program

Leash Law

Chief Bitler would like to remind all residents of the Village's leash law. Village Ordinances require that residents must keep their animals restrained. It is unlawful to allow any dog, cat or miniature pig to roam freely outside of a fenced area or off of the owners property, without being leashed and under the control of a responsible person. You may review the entire wording for restraining animals in

Chapter six, section 4-6-3 of the Village Code.

Village Ordinances also prohibit allowing any animal to habitually or continually disturb the peace by loud noises at any time of the day or night. You may review the entire wording in Chapter six, section 4-5-6 of the Village Code.

Crime Tips

Please assist your police department by taking precautions against property crime.

- When not home lock all doors and windows.
- Always lock your vehicle when you leave it.
- Don't leave valuables in your vehicle.
- Turn on outside lights at night.
- Don't leave valuable items unsecured outside.
- Report any suspicious activity in your neighborhood.
